To Whom It May Concern:

The City of Portland has received an application for a Full On-Premises Sales liquor license in your neighborhood, which allows the sale of distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine and cider by the drink for consumption ON the premises. A more complete description of the proposed outlet, including hours of operation, is contained in the enclosed Business Information Form.

This application is being considered by the City for recommendation to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. Property owners, residents, neighborhood associations and other interested parties will be given approximately twenty days from the date of this letter for input. Written comments with <u>factual information related to the sale and service of alcohol</u> are the most useful. Although copies of this letter are sent to listed residents when possible, property owners are requested to forward this notice to appropriate residents at the premises to ensure they have the opportunity to respond. Please note that Operational information provided in this notice is based on initial information from the applicant. Hours of operation and entertainment may change without notice to the City of Portland or the Community.

If you do not have any comments, no further action is required. If you wish to oppose or support this application, please submit your written comments by <u>August 2, 2018</u>. Submissions become public record and are available to the applicant. List your name and address on the attached form if you wish to be notified of any City action regarding this application.
