

Do you know that your 72-hour emergency kit should include at least 1 gallon of water per person *and* at least 1 cup/per 10 lbs. per pet for each day?

That means a two person household with one 10 lb. pet should have a minimum of 6 1/4 gallons of water on hand to survive 3 days in the event of an emergency.

Many sources say that you can not survive more than 3 days without water.
